



Policy: Preferential rates for residents Updated and adopted July 7th 2022

POLICY STATEMENT

The present policy aims to offer preferential rates to residents or property owners within one of the member municipalities of the Corporation du Parc régional du lac 31 Milles.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all permanent residents, validated by photo ID showing home address, and to property owners validated by assessment roll or municipal tax bill.

Only municipalities bordering Lake 31 Milles and represented on the board of directors of the park qualify. In 2022 these municipalities included Bouchette, Sainte-Thérèse-de-la-Gatineau, Notre-Dame-de-Pontmain, Délégé and the City of Gracefield.

PREFERENTIAL RATES

Upon confirmation of a valid proof of residency or property ownership, and over the same year, the customer is entitled to:

- One free camping stay on one of the sites for a maximum of up to 5 consecutive nights (excluding ready-to-camp installations, RV camping and rooms at the Auberge).
- Unlimited free parking at the boat launch of the client's municipality only.

RESERVATION METHOD

The resident or property owner must make his own reservation using the Park's online reservation system and his own credit card. Once the reservation has been completed and paid for, proof of residence or ownership must be submitted to the Corporation du Parc régional du lac 31 Milles by e-mail to obtain the applicable refund and/or rebate. Allow up to 5 days for reimbursement to be credited by the banking institutions.

RESTRICTIONS

Only one preferential rate is granted per civic address, regardless of the number of occupants or the number of co-owners of a property.

The name used on the reservation must match the name on the proof of residence. This same person must be physically present during the stay.

It is strictly forbidden to use a proof of residence to acquire complementary stays for reuse or resale to a third party. Random identity checks will be performed at boat launched as well as during the patrols on the lake.

MODIFICATIONS

The present policy can be modified without notice. However, the modifications cannot be retroactive.
